He is a Fellow of the African Academy of Sciences, the Royal Entomological Society, the Entomological Society of America (ESA), Member of the Council of the International Congress of Entomology and from 2020-2023 was the Chairman of the Board of the *International Institute of Tropical Agriculture* (IITA – www.iita.org). CB has been the recipient of the 2011 International Plant Protection Award of Distinction of the International Association for the Plant Protection Sciences (IAPPS), and the 2015 Distinguished Scientist Award of ESA's International Branch. He has authored and co-authored > 250 papers in peer-reviewed scientific journals, with > 9,500 citations and an hindex of 52, has co-authored a book on biological control in Africa, and has written > 10 chapters for different scientific books.
